For everyone's safety, please note and share the following guidelines.

Increased Space and Social Distancing

We have made preparations to accommodate more people for Ramadan compared to Jumma prayers, while maintaining social distancing. Thus the masjid will be open for daily prayers, including isha and taraweeh prayers, with following guidelines, inshaAllah.

Isha & Taraweeh Prayers

- Isha will be followed by a short taraweeh prayer each day.
- Sisters' areas will remain open for all prayers.
- Babysitting will NOT be provided. Children can join prayer if they can pray with a parent.
- Social distancing requirements will continue.
- Face masks will be required.
- Everyone must bring their own prayer rug.
- Bathroom and wudu area access will be limited and is discouraged.

Drive-Thru Iftar
